INSTRUCTIONS TO THE HEADS OF THE INSTITUTIONS FOR FILLING UP OF FORMS FOR

D.El.Ed. EXAMINATION, 2026 (1st YEAR, 1st YEAR BACK, 2nd YEAR & 2nd YEAR BACK)

1. The filling up of application forms for D.El.Ed. Examination, 2026 (1st Year, 1st Year Back, 2nd Year & 2nd Year Back) shall be done through ONLINE mode only by visiting the official website of the Board www.bseodisha.nic.in 24X7 from 28/08/2026 to 06/09/2026.

2. All formalities relating to filling up of the forms shall be completed within the stipulated date notified by the Board. No further extension shall ordinarily be allowed.

3. The Heads of Institutions of DIETs/BIETs/ETEs & ST Schools shall be responsible for filling up and submission of the application forms for D.El.Ed. Examination, 2026 strictly in accordance with the Regulation of Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.), 2012, Chapter-X-D (A).

4. The Heads of Institutions are required to go through the step-by-step instructions and other relevant information available on the official website of the Board before undertaking the online submission process.

5. Fees for the Examination:

6. The examination fee payable by each candidate shall be reflected automatically in the online application. The Head of the Institutions are to deposit the fees in cash/ NEFT/RTGS in the account Number of the Board mentioned in the application form. After deposit of fees the UTR number and deposit slip are to be uploaded in the website for Final Submission. **Offline payment of Exam fee could be deposited and updated in the website by the midnight of 08/09/2026.**

The fee structure applicable for the D.El.Ed. Examination, 2026 (1st yr/ 1st yr back/2nd yr/ 2nd yr back) is as follows :

- a. For SC/ST Students : ₹ 1400/-
- b. For All other Students : ₹ 1600/-

7. It is mandatory for the Head of the Institution to enter the internal marks of the candidates while filling up the forms. The profiles of all Teacher Educators shall also be entered in the online application before filling of Students' application form.

8. Eligibility of Candidates:

a. Regular Candidates – Candidates who have been duly admitted in a Teacher Education Institution and have pursued their course of study by attending classes during the year of examination, securing not less than 80% attendance in each paper, and have successfully completed the prescribed supervised practice teaching lessons, workshop-based and school-based activities, assignments and projects, duly internally assessed. Candidates must also have completed the action research project during the 2nd Year, wherever applicable, and fulfilled all other requirements prescribed under the Regulation of Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.), 2012, Chapter-X-D (A). Such candidates shall be treated as Regular Candidates.

b. A candidate who has been declared failed for not securing the prescribed aggregate marks (i.e. 565) shall be given three consecutive chances following the first appearance to secure the required aggregate marks as well as the pass marks in each theory and practical paper.

c. A candidate who fails to secure 40% marks either in the internal assessment or external assessment in a theory paper shall be allowed to clear the internal or external assessment, as the case may be, in three consecutive chances following the first appearance.

d. A candidate who is declared failed in any practical paper shall be given two consecutive chances following the first appearance to clear the concerned practical paper(s).

Note: The Examination Committee of the Board may condone a deficit in attendance not exceeding 10% for special reasons, particularly on health grounds, when the application is supported by a certificate from a registered medical practitioner or for extraordinary circumstances beyond the control of the candidate, supported by authentic evidence.

9. Question Papers: The question papers for the D.El.Ed. Examination, 2026 shall be set from the syllabus prescribed by the Board and applicable to the examination.

However, candidates who have been booked under M.P. in Back Papers shall have to appear only in those papers in which they have been booked as Back Paper candidates.

12. The medium of instruction and examination in all the theory papers, except the content-cum-pedagogy papers, i.e. Hindi, English, Urdu, Olchiki, Telugu & Persian, shall be Odia. The medium of instruction and examination in theory papers in Hindi/Sanskrit/Urdu/Persian shall be in the respective language.
